

The Life and Business in the UK

The course is aimed at broadening the students' knowledge of life in the UK, developing communicative behaviour characteristic of English-speaking cultures, raising awareness of different kinds of cultural realia and style of life.

The course is intended for those who would like to move to the UK or have recently moved. Also it will be useful for non-native teachers of English language and for students who study Linguistics.

Recommended entry level is pre-intermediate B1 and above.
